WHY WE NEED YOUR HELP

Texas has 131,198 homeless children and ranks 38th in the nation with the most homeless children, which is the 12th highest in the country. Some of these children are brought by their parents to temporary housing with friends or in motels. When there is nowhere else to go, some families resort to sleeping in a vehicle or public place.

On Friday, November 10th, 2017, the lawn of St. Andrew Presbyterian Church will become home to Cardboard Box City. This event lasts for one night and is a fundraiser and awareness campaign benefiting Longview Interfaith Hospitality Network. L.I.H.N. is a community-wide ministry that supports children and families experiencing homelessness by helping them achieve their goals and pursue a course to a stable future.

HOW DOES CARDBOARD BOX CITY WORK?

Residents purchase cardboard boxes from the organizers, either by raising pledges or making individual contributions. Residents sleep on the lawn of the church the night of the event, rain or shine.

SERVICE/YOUTH GROUPS

Cardboard Box City is open to people of all ages and affiliations. We encourage service clubs, school groups and youth organizations to use this event as a learning and team building activity.

All entertainment and activity is family friendly, and participants sleep in a secured outdoor area. A minimum of one adult per five youth under 18 years old is required. If your group would like to participate, return the attached form.
